Pregnant women are given preference in admission to services and are seen within 48 hours of their request to reduce health risks to her and her unborn child.

Services are provided on a fee for service basis. Most insurance plans and HMOs are accepted. Persons without insurance coverage are charged according to ability to pay, base on income and dependents. No one will be denied services because they are unable to pay.
