Mental Health Skill-building Eligibility

MH Skill-building Services is a skills-based training program for adults with serious mental illness (SMI). It is considered a "medically necessary" service due to the serious impairments and functional limitations identified by specific diagnoses.

Intake assessments are conducted prior to or at admission to determine whether the individual meets the program admission criteria: what the individual's immediate service, health, and safety needs are; and whether the provider has the capability and staffing to provide the needed services. Subsequent reassessments shall be conducted on a semi-annual basis or as needed.
