Who can Rappel?

Adventurists, teammates, co-workers, friends, family, you name it! This day and age, almost *everyone* knows *someone* affected by addiction. Addiction impacts family dynamics, friendships, and life altogether. Come out, show your support, and **#RAPPELFORAREASON**. Do you have what it takes?

How do I participate?
