
Representatives from Genoa will be available to provide additional information and coordination support to the successful bidder during the design and construction phases.

Build-Out Notes

The following requirements apply to the pharmacy build-out:

- Perimeter walls to extend from floor to deck above.
- Reinforcements to be provided around all entrance points.
- Maintain a constant temperature of 72°F.
- Tankless Water Heater: Must provide 105°F hot water within 30 seconds, in accordance with organizational policy.

Illustrative Examples

Two illustrative examples are attached for reference:

- 1. Floor plans from a recent SEVHS construction project; and
- 2. A sample plan for an open pod arrangement recommended by the Primary Care Development Corporation (PCDC) as part of the SEVHS and CBH technical assistance initiative.

GENERAL NOTES

- A. PLAN DIMENSIONS ARE FROM THE FACE OF STUD UNLESS OTHERWISE
- B. CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION. ANY DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ARCHITECT FOR RESOLUTION.
- C. REFER TO DEMOLITION SHEET <u>AD-101</u> FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRING COORDINATION WITH NEW WORK, NOTES, AND DETAILS.
- D. PATCH AND REPAIR ALL EXISTING CONCRETE FLOOR SLABS DAMAGED BY DEMOLITION OPERATIONS (SUCH AS EXISTING PLUMBING, PIPING, AND ELECTRICAL CONDUIT ABANDONED BELOW FLOOR; OR NEW UTILITIES INSTALLED UNDER EXISTING FLOOR) WITH CONCRETE TO MATCH EXISTING. PROVIDE FLUSH CONCRETE CONDITION SUITABLE FOR NEW FLOOR FINISH.
- E. PROVIDE SOLID FIRE RETARDANT TREATED WOOD BLOCKING WITHIN STUD AND FURRING SPACES BEHIND ALL WALL MOUNTED ACCESSORIES, EQUIPMENT, ETC. AS REQUIRED FOR SECURE ANCHORAGE.
- F. REFER TO <u>A-601</u> FOR INTERIOR FINISH DESIGNATION AND INFORMATION.
- G. CONCEAL ALL CONDUIT, WIRE, BOXES, PIPE, ETC. IN WALLS TO ENSURE THERE ARE NO EXPOSED UTILITIES. PATCH EXISTING WALLS WHERE
- H. GENERAL CONTRACTOR TO COORDINATE WORK OF ALL TRADES. VERIFY LOCATIONS AND EXTENTS OF SLEEVES, CHASES, HANGERS, INSERTS, ANCHORS, PENETRATIONS, ETC. REQUIRED BY MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL, AND PLUMBING TRADES.
- I. SEE EQUIPMENT PLAN A-401 FOR TENANT EQUIPMENT LOCATIONS. COORDINATE FINAL LOCATIONS WITH OWNER.



J. PROVIDE NEW GWB ON ALL EXISTING INTERIOR WALLS TO REMAIN AND

KEY NOTES

- 1 ALIGN GWB OF NEW WALL WITH GWB OF EXISTING WALL TO CREATE A SEAMLESS LOOK. WHERE NEW METAL STUDS INFILL OR ADJOIN EXISTING TO REMAIN WOOD FRAMING, A SKIM COAT WILL NEED TO BE PROVIDED TO CREATE SMOOTH FINISH.
- 2 PROVIDE WF1 ON INSIDE OF STOREFRONT WINDOW.
- PROVIDE FIVE (5) WHITE MELAMINE SHELVES 3/4" THICK BY 15" DEEP AND WIDTH AS REQUIRED WITH FINISHES EDGES ON HEAVY DUTY K&V ADJUSTABLE STANDARDS AND BRACKETS. PROVIDE BLOCKING AS REQUIRED.
- PROVIDE CARD READER AND ELECTRIC STRIKE, THIS DOOR REFERENCE ELECTRICAL DRAWINGS AND DOOR HARDWARE FOR ADDITIONAL
- 5 COORIDOR WALLS TO ALIGN.
- 6 PROVIDE 3/4" PLYWOOD ALL WALLS FOR THIS ROOM. PAINT PT1.


