



Medication-Assisted Treatment

Do you want to take control of your opiate use?

Colonial Behavioral Health can provide financial assistance for medication-assisted treatment. Services include outpatient office-based withdrawal management in close coordination with on-site counseling services. Care Coordination and Peer Recovery Services are also available.

Admission Criteria:

- Age 18 or older;
- Physiologically dependent on opioids and requires outpatient treatment to prevent withdrawal;
- Willing to participate in outpatient counseling;
- Not scheduled for a medical procedure or surgery that will require pain medication.
